## Safepath / TAP

• Trustees are awaiting wetlands delineation for phase two of Oceanside Cemetery expansion.

### Budget for Fiscal Year 2023 (01JUL22-30JUN23)

Remaining budget: Town account has \$12,931.31 remaining.

Burials/Paperwork/Memorials

#### Oceanside:

- Hamblett Stone is placed.
- Ms. Patricia Baker. Thursday Nov 17<sup>th</sup>. Received documentation and picture of burial monument. Oceanside Row 42-8.
- Bernard Doherty burial Friday November 18<sup>th</sup> at Oceanside. Carol has documentation. (family owns lot 45-5 and 45-6).
- Douglas Birns buried on Oct 30, 2022. The lot number is row 41 lot 1, next to tombstone marked Levin.

Riverside:

• Resident asked if it's possible to have their and their spouse's name/dates added to sibling's gravestone at Riverside. Per rules and regulations, Memorial stones with no burials are not allowed. Terri spoke with family and they are aware of regulation that a portion of cremains must be buried in the lot.

#### **Maintenance and Projects**

#### Oceanside:

- Flags are down for season.
- Maisley and Terri planted spring bulbs
- New Castle resident asks about markers for gravesites during wintertime. A ground-level shepherd's hook not to exceed three feet in height is recommended.
- Water is turned off at Oceanside.
- Granite posts on the roadside need to be re-installed.

## Riverside:

- Maisley and Terri planted spring bulbs
- Fence repair complete
- Estimate is needed for building shed lot plots.
- Water is turned off for the season. Water connection is located at the road on the left side of the Riverside entrance.
- Carol spoke with ancestor about their grandparents' graves at Riverside -Doug & Geraldine Woodward. One side of the flat stone was sinking into the ground. Carol gave permission to lift the stones up and put more dirt underneath to level them.

## Prescott:

## Frost:

• Carol, Maisley and Terri completed cleaning stones at Frost. Maisley and Terri planted spring bulbs October 29, 2022.

## **Equipment and Supplies**

• Probe is lost, mistakenly thrown away. A new one is being researched.

## **Rules and Regulations**

- Need to reconsider number of flat stone plaques per lot for cremains.
- Discussion regarding changing rules or granting exceptions.
- We, Cemetery Trustees unanimously agree under rules and regulations that a ground-level shepherd's hook, not to exceed three feet in height are permitted in the cemetery.

- **Spring Project :** Oceanside granite posts to be cleaned, per resident request.
