

## MINUTES FOR SEPTEMBER 20, 2017

### **New Castle Cemetery Trustees monthly meeting at New Castle Town Hall, 3.30 p.m.**

Present: Jim Cerny, Holly Fraumeni, Terri Golter, Carol White,

1 - The August minutes were approved.

2.1 – The budget is the same as last month. Mike has recently given us new invoices for mowing which will show up next month.

**Terri** will contact Mike about some fill and seeding which needs to be done before the end of October.

Terri replaced all the flags at Oceanside because they were all ragged.

**Terri & Holly** will remove all the flags at Riverside later this fall and will mark on the cemetery map where all the veterans are buried.

4.1 – **Jim** will send Manny an e-mail that we are still waiting on the ground penetrating radar people to set a date to retry finding the cremation urn of Suzanne Chance.

4.2 – The St. Germaine family has removed the dead tree which had fallen down into the Marvin Cemetery. **Terri** will send the family a thank you note.

4.3 & 4.4 – Jim has suggested to Laurie Clark the idea that her entire family be buried, in the future, on Laurie's private lot which will become a part of Riverside Cemetery. **Jim** will contact Laurie about what her final decision is about her private cemetery becoming part of Riverside as we have heard that her property recently sold and these changes need to be made before the final papers are passed. The town attorney is presently researching the title to the private cemetery property.

4.5 – Rona will add a flat stone on the Jones lot where her husband, Foster will be buried. This will be a cremation.

4.6 – Bobbie Sweet bought 32,5 at Oceanside. The paperwork was signed.

4.7 – Peter Menger purchased lots 39,7 and 39,8 in Oceanside.

4.8 – David & Marilyn (Straw) Flores sent Jim a check to purchase two more lots though we had said that they could only purchase one more lot. They want to purchase 43,10 & 43,11. Jim decided that we will sell them the two lots as their children are eligible to purchase lots for themselves so we will allow the parents to make the extra purchase.

4.9 – John & Beth Paulson want to buy lot 13,1 at Oceanside however their check has not arrived yet.

4.10 – We need to locate the Colby and Kimball cremation certificates. **Jim** will ask Tim Griffin if he has them.

4.11 - The Burns family filled out paperwork to purchase lot 4,1 at Oceanside. Unfortunately, it was already sold. **Jim** will call them about perhaps changing their purchase to lot 4,3.

4.12 – Jim talked to Amy Gworek who is Bert Palmer's daughter. **Jim** will give her a copy of the updated map of Oceanside showing lots that have not been sold yet.

4.13 – Jim talked with Michael Finn regarding family burials in Riverside. He wants to be sure there is enough room for him to be buried in the lot.

4.14 – Jim talked to Becky Schlieper in a very general way about future burials on her Riverside lot.

5.1 & 5.2 – No new information on the Thomas Tarbell gravestone in Riverside or the date for the Jared Maddock burial.

6.1 – Holly is working with Portsmouth Sign Co. on the new sign for Riverside. It will be 2' x 3', placed on the gate and will be reflective. It will be finished soon.

6.2 – **Jim** will talk to Steve Tabbutt about the new road that has appeared in the back of the Oceanside Cemetery.

6.3 – Carol has never been able to locate a deed governing the small section of empty land in Riverside Cemetery.
