New Castle Cemetery Trustees monthly meeting at New Castle Town Hall, <u>3.30</u> p.m.

1 – The March minutes were approved as corrected.

2.1 – Budget – No change to the budget. Cornerstone Tree Care charged us \$325 to remove the overgrown cedar trees at Riverside.

3.1 – The 161 sq. foot gift from the Clark/Hughes to Riverside Cemetery – after the trustees walked the piece of land in question, we agreed to the following: the current flat grave markers need to be raised a few inches above the ground level, we will remove the old chain link fence, we will leave the pachysandra where it is and will put granite posts at the corners of the Clark burial lot. This info. will be conveyed to both parties.

3.2 – Don White's family purchased lot 11,2 at Oceanside and his mother will be buried there.

3.3 - Karl Klaussen wants to bury a family member on their lot in Riverside in April.

3.4 – Denny Turmelle bought lot 46,8 at Oceanside.

3.5 – Eunice Frampton will be buried at Oceanside, May 24, at 2 p.m.

3.6 – Clint Springer will be buried at Riverside (casket) June 29 at 11 a.m.

3.7 - Eldred Straw will be buried at Oceanside (casket) 46,5 on May 17, 10 a.m.

3.8 - Judy Hallisey will determine which lot she owns - 9,4 or 9,5 - for an upcoming burial

3.9 – Menger foundation to be poured at Oceanside lot 39,7 or 39,8. Jim will determine which is the correct lot.

3.10 – Scott Sylvester bought Oceanside lot 4,6, which completes that row.

3.11 - Ellen Garvey purchased Oceanside lot 3,4 which completes that row.

Other Business

Water line to Riverside – The town will pay to have a spigot put in at the entrance to Riverside when the new water line is installed in town.

Monument repair – Due to this fiscal year's expenses, we're going to postpone gravestone repair until the next fiscal year. Carol will contact Kai and ask him to come out in June or July to give us an estimate. It appears we can spend up to \$1,000.

We authorized Terri to buy the needed flags for the cemeteries and take the money from the monument repair fund.

We need a more powerful light on the flagpole at Riverside as the current light does not properly illuminate the flag at night. This new light should cost \$400 and will come out of the monument repair fund also.,
