New Castle Supervisors of the Checklist Holding Session for Verification of the Checklist

New Hampshire law requires that the Supervisors of the Checklist verify the voter checklist every ten years. Any person on the checklist who has not voted in the past four years must re-register to remain on the checklist. The Supervisors are sending notice letters to these voters at the mailing address the voter provided when registering. The Supervisors of the Checklist for the Town of New Castle, NH will hold a public session to approve which voters will be sent a 2021 Verification of Checklist letter on:

In accordance with RSA 654:39, those voters who received the 2021 Verification of Checklist letter must have an opportunity to re-register. The Supervisors of the Checklist for the Town of New Castle will hold a public session for re-registering voters who have not voted since April 1, 2017, accepting applications for new voter registration, accepting requests for the correction of the checklist and or change of party affiliation on:

Date: Tuesday July 13, 2021

Time: 6:30-7:30PM

Location: New Castle Town Hall, 49 Main St, New Castle, NH

New voters may register at this time who possess proof of identity (photo ID), age, citizenship (birth certificate, passport, NOT driver's license) and verifiable proof of domicile (i.e., bank statement, utility bill, car registration, or lease/deed with street address, PO Box is not acceptable). These applicants should bring that proof when they come to register. Qualified applicants who do not possess proof of identity, or who do not bring proof with them, may sign an affidavit attesting to their qualifications for identity, age and citizenship. Qualified applicants without proof of domicile may register to vote if they sign an affidavit attesting to their domicile.

The state of New Hampshire has a website available to the public that allows all registered voters to search for their voter information. All registered voters can retrieve their party affiliation by entering their Town, First and Last Name along with their Date of Birth.
