RE: The Preservation Company Building and Site Survey

The Town of New Castle and the Historic District Commission has hired The Preservation Company to conduct a Town wide Area Form that will provide an overview of the history of New Castle and an inventory of its architecture and historic sites, and photographs of significant buildings, views, and landscapes. It summarizes the historical development of the town as well as gives a description of the architectural styles, building types, and characteristics of the built environment. This document is a tool that will assist the Historic District Commission as well as supplement the town's Master Plan.

Preservation Company will perform fieldwork and research to record the all of the historic structures, buildings, and sites in the town in the coming months. You will see their grey VW Touareg as it drives through town and takes pictures of the historic houses. This is phase one of a two phase process that will last a couple of years, funding permitting.

This project is funded entirely by a grant through the National Park Service/State of New Hampshire Certified Local Government program.
