MINUTES OF THE SELECT BOARD Monday January 3, 2022, 7:00 PM Macomber Room / Via Zoom

Present: Tom Maher-Chair, Dave McGuckin-Selectman, William Stewart-Selectman via Zoom and Jennifer Smith- Administrative Assistant to the Select Board and Recording Secretary.

Public Participants via Zoom: Chris Robillard-DPW Superintendent and Dawn Lake-President of the Historical Society.

Chairman Maher opened the public session meeting at 7:00PM.

1. Approve Select Board minutes of December 20, 2021

Selectman McGuckin made a motion to approve the Select Board minutes of December 20, 2021. Selectman Stewart seconded and the motion carried unanimously, 3-0.

2. Public Questions and Answers

No public comments were offered.

3. New Business

a. Covid

Chairman Maher stated that Dr. Kathy Hollister, Health Officer, issued a new update today regarding additional vaccine opportunities and information about how the variant is making its way into New Hampshire. Chairman Maher further stated that some surrounding communities are mandating masks in town hall. While the Select Board strongly advises those entering town hall to wear a mask, masks are not mandated.

4. Town Projects Update

Chairman Maher stated that renovations at town hall are finally coming to a close. The work in all 3 offices has been completed with just 2 offices awaiting the delivery of desks. The Town Clerk's Office will re-open for DMV needs on January 5, 2022.

The Select Board members expressed their gratitude to the Town of Greenland and the Greenland Town Clerk's Office for all their help processing New Castle residents' DMV needs while our Town Clerk Office has been unable to.

Chairman Maher stated that the town is still working on IT upgrades, including a new file server and Microsoft 365 to hopefully be installed over the next few weeks. A new IT closet has been constructed and the first of two fire walls have been ordered.

Selectman Stewart stated that the work on Locke Road went well and has been completed for all intents and purposes. The second section of the project, Main Mast, is beginning work now. Selectman Stewart

asked Chris Robillard, DPW Superintendent, if he had any updates regarding the status of the current project.

Mr. Robillard stated that the pipe was put in the ground today and, as expected, ledge has been difficult in the area. Sample testing is anticipated to happen at the end of the week and the project should wrap up mid-January.

5. Safe Path Donation

Chairman Maher read into the record a donation to Safe Path Committee from Joe Cuetara and Bonnie Rossi for \$500.

Selectman McGuckin offered a motion to accept the aforementioned donation to the Safe Path Committee. Selectman Stewart seconded and said motion carried unanimously, 3-0.

6. Old Business

a. Historical Society Lease agreement

Chairman Maher directed his statement to Dawn Lake, President of the Historical Society, via Zoom, informing her that the Select Board is currently working with DPW to come to an arrangement regarding snow removal at the lease site. The Select Board is considering the option of having DPW temporarily remove the snow from the walk ways and then send the Historical Society an invoice to cover the costs.

Ms. Lake stated that, in addition to the walkway, the path to where the heating fuel is delivered must be shoveled as well.

Selectman McGuckin stated that the lease was finalized today and asked Ms. Lake if she could come to town hall to sign it.

Ms. Lake agreed and thanked the Select Board for their time and efforts.

7. Committee Reports

Chairman Maher stated that the Fire Department and Police Department monthly reports would be attached to this meeting's minutes.

8. Adjourn

Selectman McGuckin offered a motion to adjourn at 7:21 pm. Selectman Stewart seconded and said motion passed unanimously, 3-0.
