Legal Notice TOWN OF NEW CASTLE, NH

The SUPERVISORS OF THE CHECKLIST will be in session at the New Castle Town Hall on Friday evening October 25, 2019 between 7-7:30pm. In addition to registering new voters, October 25th is the last time registered voters may change their party affiliation prior to the 2020 Presidential Primary. During the primary election day registered Undeclared voters may select a Republican or Democrat ballot and will have the opportunity to return to their previous Undeclared status when exiting the primary.

New voters may register at this time who possess proof of identity (photo ID), age, citizenship (birth certificate, passport, NOT driver's license) and verifiable proof of domicile (ie. utility bill, car registration, lease with street address or valid driver's license with legal street address). These applicants should bring that proof when they come to register. Qualified applicants who do not possess proof of identity, or who do not bring proof with them, may sign an affidavit attesting to their qualifications for identity, age and citizenship. Qualified applicants without proof of domicile may register to vote if they sign an affidavit attesting to their domicile.

Reports of voter transfer, death or removal of names along with address or name changes, can be made to the Checklist of registered voters at this session as well as any change in party affiliation.

After October 25th any voter who wishes to change their party affiliation will need to wait until the day after the 2020 Presidential Primary to make the change.

The state of New Hampshire has a website available to the public that allows all registered voters to search for their voter information. All registered voters can retrieve their party affiliation by entering their Town, First and Last Name along with their Date of Birth.
