

# Legal Notice

## TOWN OF NEW CASTLE, NH

The SUPERVISORS OF THE CHECKLIST will be in public session at the Recreation Building on Tuesday June 2, 2020 between 7-7:30pm. This notice also serves as the announcement that June 3-12, 2020 is the filing period for all offices for the state primary election.

Session purpose:

1. For Supervisors to correct and update the Checklist ahead of the local postponed elections of May 12, 2020 now to be held on June 23, 2020. Reports of voter transfer, death or removal of names along with address or name changes, can be made to the Checklist of registered voters at this session. New voter registrations will be accepted during the meeting. This voter registration opportunity is in addition to the normal Town Clerk hours.
2. This is the last day for registered voters to change party affiliation prior to the September 8, 2020 State Primary.

***No new voter registrations will be accepted after June 2, 2020 until the June 23, 2020 Town Election.*** Any resident unable to attend the June 23rd election and requires a new registration, can apply for an absentee ballot packet by contacting the Town Clerk and requesting an absentee ballot along with a new voter registration application. Any new registrations received after June 23rd will not be added to the Town Voter Checklist until the September 8, 2020 election.

If the Governor's current Stay-At-Home directive is extended beyond May 31st, instructions will be provided on how to access a virtual meeting.

**Additional registration details** New voters may register who possess proof of identity (photo ID), age, citizenship (birth certificate, passport, NOT driver's license) and verifiable proof of domicile (i.e. utility bill, car registration, or lease with street address NOT PO Box). These applicants should bring that proof when they come to register. Qualified applicants who do not possess proof of identity, or who do not bring proof with them, may sign an affidavit attesting to their qualifications for identity, age and citizenship. Qualified applicants without proof of domicile may register to vote if they sign an affidavit attesting to their domicile.

The state of New Hampshire has a website available to the public that allows all registered voters to search for their voter information. All registered voters can retrieve their party affiliation by entering their Town, First and Last Name along with their Date of Birth.
