TOWN ELECTION

The Town Election is rescheduled to June 23, 2020. Per NH RSA 669:1 V(c) and RSA 669:1- this notice represents our third postponement to arrive at this date. Polls will be open at **9am – 7pm** at the **New Castle Recreation building**. Please note the COVID-19 precautions below:

- **Entrance:** please enter in the marked door to the right (south) of the main lobby. The main lobby will remain available as a handicap entrance ONLY.
- **Hand Sanitization:** all residents are required to sanitize their hands at the sanitization station located at the entrance of the building
- **Face Masks:** all residents must wear a face mask to enter the building. Please bring your own face mask. If you do not have a face mask, one will be provided to you.
- **Flow Pattern:** please follow the marked new flow pattern. Floor arrows and railing guide will be set-up. If you have a question, ask an election official.
- **Social Distancing:** The floor is marked every 6' for proper social distancing.
- **Voting Tables:** after check-in, proceed with your ballot and mini pencil to the VOTER TABLES clearly marked with trifold "Vote Here" privacy shields. A licensed, bonded cleaning service sanitizes each table between voters. Please be patient. Keep your ballot with you until casting into the ballot box. You may keep the pencil.
- **Exit:** all voters will exit in the back of the building using the handicap ramp.
- **Special Note:** If you refuse to sanitize your hands or wear a face mask, you will be denied entrance into the building. However, an election official will contact the Moderator (or his designee) to provide you with an alternative pathway to vote outside the building—no eligible voter will be denied the right to vote in this election.
