New Castle Parking Changes effective March 27, 2020

To comply with recent Federal and State orders and guidelines, the Town is restricting parking in some areas and limiting parking to residents only in several locations.

The following changes are effective immediately:

- The New Castle Common and Beach are closed to all vehicle traffic.
- The Town parking areas off Wentworth Road near the Coast Guard Station and the UNH Pier are changed to resident parking only at all times.
- Ocean Road will be posted as local traffic only and no parking. There are three resident parking spaces near the beach that will remain available for residents to park.
- Piscataqua Street and Cranfield Street are converting to one-way traffic only (in accordance with summer traffic patterns).
- Parking on Piscataqua Street and Cranfield Street is restricted to resident only parking at all times.
- Parking on Wild Rose Lane, where currently permitted, is restricted to resident only parking at all times.
- The parking area at the Recreation Building and Library is restricted to resident parking only at all times.

Please know that we are aware some residents do not have their current sticker yet. The police will be looking for any age resident sticker on the car. In the absence of a sticker, they will run your license plate to determine if you are a resident. **New stickers are not available for pick up at this time with Town Hall closed to the public.**
