

WEDDINGS AT THE COMMON

We have many requests and questions about weddings at our town park at the Common. Here are a few FAQ's for those thinking about using the park for their ceremony.

1. What do you require to have a wedding ceremony?

The Town does not require anything to have a wedding ceremony at the Common.

2. What are the hours can a ceremony be held?

The park is open 365 per year from 9am until 9pm during the summer and 9am till dusk during winter.

3. Can I have alcohol at the wedding?

The wedding functions are regulated under the same rules as any other guests to the town park and alcohol is not permitted.

4. Can I have a horse drawn carriage?

All horse drawn carriages must have the permission of the park manager.

5. Can I rope off a section of the park for my ceremony?

We do not allow sectioning off of any park of the park.

6. Can I enter the park for pictures before 9am?

All special requests must be presented to the park manager for permission.

7. How can I pay for all of guests attending ahead of time.

Arrangements for guest payments must be done through the gate attendants.

8. Can I have music?

All music whether live or recorded must be nonintrusive to others using the park.

9. Do you have access to electricity?

No access to electricity and generators must be approved by the park manager.

10. Can I set up chairs for my wedding?

This is at the discretion of the park manager.
