TOWN OF NEW CASTLE, NH

The SUPERVISORS OF THE CHECKLIST will be in session at the New Castle Recreation Building located at 301 Wentworth Rd on **Wednesday January 13, 2021 from 5-5:30pm**. This meeting will be the **last day to accept voter registration applications for the January 20, 2021 Special Town Meeting**. [New voter registrations cannot take place during this Special Town Meeting].

During this Supervisor session reports of voter transfer, death or removal of names along with address or name changes, can be made to the Checklist of registered voters. For those voters that **used an absentee ballot to vote during the September 8, 2020 primary** this is an opportunity to **change back to Undeclared status** for those interested in doing so.

New voters may register at this time who possess proof of identity (photo ID), age, citizenship (birth certificate, passport, NOT driver's license) and verifiable proof of domicile (i.e., bank statement, utility bill, car registration, or lease/deed with street address, PO Box is not acceptable). These applicants should bring that proof when they come to register. Qualified applicants who do not possess proof of identity, or who do not bring proof with them, may sign an affidavit attesting to their qualifications for identity, age and citizenship. Qualified applicants without proof of domicile may register to vote if they sign an affidavit attesting to their domicile.

The state of New Hampshire has a website available to the public that allows all registered voters to search for their voter information. All registered voters can retrieve their party affiliation by entering their Town, First and Last Name along with their Date of Birth.
