The SUPERVISORS OF THE CHECKLIST will be in session at the New Castle Town Hall located at 49 Main Street, New Castle, NH on **Tuesday, March 22, 2022 from 7:00 - 7:30 p.m.** 

During this Supervisor session reports of voter transfer, death or removal of names, address or name changes, as well as change in party affiliation can be made to the Checklist of registered voters.

\*Because Covid protocols were in place during the 2020 Presidential and State Primaries, the process for changing affiliation BACK TO UNDECLARED was then managed by written request only. For those interested in changing back to Undeclared status ahead of the next Primary, this is an opportunity to do so.\*

New voters may register at this time who possess — and present at the time of registration — proof of identity (photo ID), age, citizenship (birth certificate, passport, NOT driver's license) and verifiable proof of domicile (i.e., bank statement, utility bill, car registration, or lease/deed with street address, PO Box is not acceptable). Qualified applicants who do not possess proof of identity, age, and citizenship, or who do not bring proof with them, may sign an affidavit of attestation. Qualified applicants without proof of domicile may register to vote if they sign an affidavit attesting to their domicile.

The state of New Hampshire has a website available to the public that allows all registered voters to search for their voter information. All registered voters can retrieve their party affiliation by entering their Town, First and Last Name along with their Date of Birth. <u>https://app.sos.nh.gov/public/partyinfo.aspx</u>

In addition, the voter checklist is posted outside the Town Clerk's Office and at the New Castle Recreation Building for review.
