**Voter Registration and Absentee Ballot Drop Off**

Reminder absentee ballots must be received by the town clerk  
before 5 PM on November 3rd

The SUPERVISORS OF THE CHECKLIST will be in session at the New Castle Recreation Building located at 301 Wentworth Rd on **Tuesday October 27<sup>th</sup> between 1:30-2:30pm**. Entrance will be through the back door only. This will be the **last day to accept voter registration applications until the November 3, 2020 election**. Reports of voter transfer, death or removal of names along with address or name changes, can be made to the Checklist of registered voters at this session. **Completed and signed absentee ballots will accepted at this session.**

New voters may register at this time who possess proof of identity (photo ID), age, citizenship (birth certificate, passport, NOT driver's license) and verifiable proof of domicile (i.e. bank statement, utility bill, car registration, or lease with street address, PO Box is not acceptable). These applicants should bring that proof when they come to register. Qualified applicants who do not possess proof of identity, or who do not bring proof with them, may sign an affidavit attesting to their qualifications for identity, age and citizenship. Qualified applicants without proof of domicile may register to vote if they sign an affidavit attesting to their domicile.

The state of New Hampshire has a website available to the public that allows all registered voters to search for their voter information. All registered voters can retrieve their party affiliation by entering their Town, First and Last Name along with their Date of Birth.
